Course Overview

This Art and Design course helps you explore your creativity through structured projects. You will gain essential skills, build confidence in your talent and discover various career opportunities in the art world. Perfect for developing your artistic talents and preparing for future job demands.

Course Content

The knowledge, skills and behaviours acquired on the programme, will prepare you for progression to Level 3 creative pathways, including Art and Design, Fashion Design or Graphic Design.

How will I be assessed?

You will periodically present your folder of work to your personal tutor for your evaluation record to be updated. There will also be external testing of selected units, including controlled test elements.

You will require a basic personal and portable kit of materials and equipment. Your tutor will advise you on the best drawing, painting and technical equipment that you will need.
