- GCSE Grade C or above in English Language (or the equivalent).

## **Course Overview**

Enrolment for the January start will take place on Wednesday 8 January. After making an application you will be booked in to an available timeslot.

This course is ideal for those seeking to enhance their functional role through the use of counselling skills, e.g. professionals in education, welfare or voluntary roles.

## Key topics:

- Developing counselling skills
- Theoretical approaches in the use of counselling skills
- Working ethically with counselling skills
- Counselling skills and diversity
- Counselling skills and personal development

This qualification does not qualify students to practise as a counsellor.

## **Course Content**

#### How will I be assessed?

- Continuous assessment through assignments/reflective journals and a portfolio of evidence.
- Candidates must submit a completed portfolio of evidence by the end of the course for final assessment. External verifier may request photocopying part of your portfolio but your confidentiality will be maintained at all times.
- Minimum 90% attendance, which will be monitored throughout the course.

#### Free Courses For Jobs

If you are aged 19 or over, you may not have to pay for this course if:

- You do not already have a level 3 qualification OR
- You already have a level 3 qualification or higher but earn below the earnings threshold set by your local authority, which includes benefits (see below) OR
- You already have a level 3 qualification or higher but are unemployed and in receipt of a meanstested benefit, below the earnings threshold set by your local authority (see below).

This course is funded by South Yorkshire Mayoral Combined Authority (SYMCA) and/or West Yorkshire Combined Authority (WYCA). You must be living in the South or West Yorkshire regions to qualify for funding.

## Earnings Threshold

- If you live in the qualifying **West Yorkshire** region and earn below £25,000 a year then you may not have to pay for this course.
- If you live in the qualifying **South Yorkshire** region and earn below £30,476 a year then you may not have to pay for this course.
