In Brief

Start Date / Duration

Entry Requirements

This course is planning to start on Friday 25 April. Lessons will be every Friday between 9.15am and 12.15pm for 9 weeks, termtime only. There is no requirement for you to have achieved any qualifications or units prior to undertaking this qualification, however a reasonable standard of computing skills will be required.

You must be aged 19 or above to study this course.

You will achieve

Level 2 Award in Cybersecurity (Gateway Qualification)

Course Overview

This qualification is designed to provide you with knowledge of the principles of Cybersecurity. You will learn about cybercrime and the risks and effects it has on individuals and businesses, routine protective methods used to maintain cybersecurity, including the principles of vulnerability and penetration testing and user access control.

Course Content

As well as learning the principles of vulnerability and penetration testing and user access control, you will learn about cybercrime and the risks and effects it has on individuals and organisations.

You will study:

- Security protection and risk management issues.
- Vulnerabilities.
- Measures to protect IT systems and data from current and evolving threats.
- Implementing measures to protect IT systems and data.
- Understanding current legal and ethical requirements, and IT security policies and procedures.

How will I be assessed?

You will be assessed using a range of methods such as practical tasks and written coursework within a portfolio of evidence. This portfolio will be used to determine your grade.

All equipment will be provided.

Eligibility for Funding

You will need to provide evidence of your eligibility which will be checked at enrolment.
