Entry Requirements

You need to be aged 19 or above. No previous formal qualifications are required.

You will achieve

Level 2 Certificate in Understanding Adverse Childhood Experiences.

Course Overview

This qualification provides an understanding of adverse childhood experiences (ACEs) relevant to your current or future roles in the Childcare and Education industry.

It focuses on the 0-8 age range and equips you with techniques to prevent and address ACEs, relevant to your job role or interests.

You will study:

- Exploring childhood and family structures
- Introduction to adverse childhood experiences
- Understanding strategies to improve outcomes for children affected by adverse childhood experience

Course Content

How will I be assessed?

You will be assessed by completing course work and assignments set by your tutor.

What Equipment Will I Need?

You will need to provide writing materials and stationery, a folder and a USB stick. Having access to a computer (computers can be accessed in College) would also be useful but it is not essential.
