You'll learn about important topics like sustainability, ethics, customer care and business management, along with specialised modules on:

- Health and Disease
- Nutrition and Feeding

Plus, you'll get hands-on experience with a 45-day industry placement!

Course Content

How will I be assessed?

Over the two years, you will be required to complete three exams, an employer set project and a synoptic assessment.

In addition, you must complete an industry placement, lasting a minimum of 315 hours.

What Equipment Will I Need?

All students on landbased programmes are required to wear standard uniform and also PPE for practical work in the form of steel toe capped boots and overalls.
