Course Overview

If you have a particular interest or are considering a career in the music industry, this study programme is for you. What can I do next?

- Employment: this course can form the foundations for future study and work in this industry
- Education: You could progress onto an Extended Diploma course at Barnsley College in an area of Music such as Music Performance [https://www.barnsley.ac.uk/course/music-performance-level-3-full-time/] or Music Production [https://www.barnsley.ac.uk/course/music-production-level-3-full-time/]. To do so, you need to achieve a Merit grade for your Diploma. To progress onto the Extended Diploma in Music Technology you need to gain GCSE Maths at grade 4/C or above. We can offer this alongside the Diploma course. Many students then continue to university.
