In Brief

Start Date / Duration

The course will run every 4 weeks or so throughout the academic year, Please apply and you will be directed to the next start date. The duration of the course is 4 weeks. Attendance is Monday-Friday.

Entry Requirements

- Learners must already have developed skills with the use of plastering tools either through previous work or training
- This course is not suited to those with no plastering experience
- No GCSE required for entry to this qualification
- You must be aged 19+

Course Overview

This intensive Level 2 qualification will provide you with a range of plaster skimming skills and knowledge ranging from using plastering tools to learning how to plaster on different surfaces. You will also develop an understanding of the health and safety requirements and self-employment. Moreover, you will enhance your communication, teamwork, research, and analysis abilities.

Course Content

You will study the following modules:

- Introducing Health and Safety in Construction
- Skills for Plaster Skimming
- Introduction to Self-Employment in Construction

The qualifications are a combination internally set and internally assessed units and externally set and externally assessed units.

You will need to provide evidence of your eligibility which will be checked at enrolment.

This course is funded by *South Yorkshire Mayoral Combined Authority (SYMCA) and/or West Yorkshire Combined Authority (WYCA)*. You must be living in the South or West Yorkshire regions to qualify for funding.
