Start Date / Duration

The course starts in September and lasts for one year.

Entry Requirements

You will need:

- A BTEC Level 3 qualification in Construction
- GCSE English and Maths at grade 4/C or above
- Other related Level 3 qualifications including an Access to Higher Education Diploma
- Relevant work experience
- Or hold an international qualification equivalent to the above

You will achieve

You will gain a Level 4 Higher National Certificate in Construction Management for England (HTQ).

Course Overview

The Level 4 units lay the foundation of learning by providing a broad introduction to construction and different construction management functions. This develops and strengthens core skills while preparing you for specialist subjects at Level 5 or to enter employment with the qualities necessary for job roles that require some personal responsibility.

Course Content

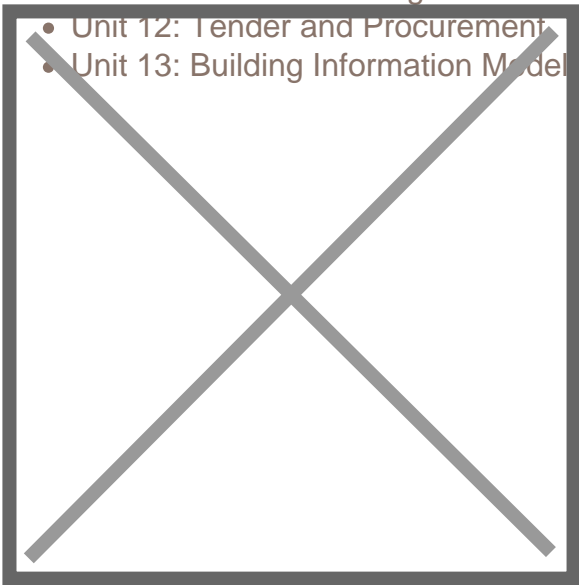
You will gain a wide range of construction knowledge linked to practical skills gained through research, independent study, directed study and workplace scenarios.

By the end of Level 4, you will have sound knowledge of the basic concepts of construction; be competent in a range of subject-specific skills; as well as holding the general skills and qualities relevant to key areas of construction.
