Bricklaying Level 2 Diploma Full-time

In Brief

Start Date / Duration

This course will commence in September 2025 and will take one year to complete.

Entry Requirements

- This course is for 16-18 years olds.
- Successful completion at Level 1 Brickwork Diploma
- OR, you must hold GCSE English and Maths. One of these qualifications must be a minimum Grade 2 and the other must be a minimum Grade 3.

Course Overview

This course covers building construction principles, masonry structures, and practical tasks like bricklaying and constructing walls, piers, and fireplaces. You will learn to interpret drawings, plan projects, and engage in decorative and reinforced brickwork. Essential employability skills such as teamwork, communication, CV writing, and self-management are also included, which are crucial for future employment.

Course Content

You will study:

- Introduction to health and safety in construction.
- Principles of building construction, information and communication.
- Contribute to setting out and building of masonry structures and complete a damp proof course.
- Carrying out block laying, bricklaying cavity and walling activities.
- Building solid walling, isolated and attached piers.
- Interpreting working drawings to set out masonry structures.
- Principles of organising, planning and pricing construction work.

- Constructing radial and battered brickwork.
- Carrying out decorative and reinforced brickwork.
- Constructing fireplaces and chimneys.
- Employability skills are general skills that you will need in most jobs. On this course you will learn a range of employability skills such as teamwork, communication, CV writing and self-management, all of which are required by employers.

How will I be assessed?

Throughout the study programme your work will be assessed for a Pass, Merit or Distinction grade. Achieving this Diploma means that you have reached the standards expected by the industry.

There are 5 points of PPE required in the workshop at all times. Each student is expected to provide their own safety boots and the department will provide the other 4 pieces:

Hard hat

Eye safety
