Level 2 Award in Website Design and Development

Course Overview

If you are interested in learning more about web design then this course can take your skills to the next level. Suitable for those with some knowledge and experience, or learners who have completed the Level 1 Award in Web Design [https://www.barnsley.ac.uk/course/computing-website-design-level-1-award-part-time/], this qualification is perfect if you want to start building more complex and detailed sites through the use of HTML and wireframe design and planning.

Course Content

You will learn how to create a website using tools and techniques to add functionality, navigation buttons and hyperlinks. Utilising the skills and knowledge learnt at level 1 you will build upon more advance design techniques and website structure and user interface/experience.

You will develop knowledge and understanding of the core areas of website design.

Unit Learning Outcomes

- Understand website fundamentals
- Design a website for a specific audience and purpose
- Plan for website design in response to a brief
- Create a website, publish and test online
- Review and refine your website

How will I be assessed?

You will be assessed using a range of methods such as practical tasks and written coursework within a portfolio of evidence. This portfolio will be used to determine your grade.

Eligibility for Funding
