#### **Course Overview**

This Foundation T Level is designed to help you explore and develop your creative media skills and knowledge in preparation for progressing to a Level 3 course. Gain insight into how the media industry operates and influences society, while building practical skills in areas such as camerawork, editing and design. Learn how to plan and execute productions, working with high-spec equipment and resources.

#### **Course Content**

You will develop an array of practical skills including editing, design and capturing, as well as using Adobe Creative Cloud. You will also explore key theoretical concepts, including audience analysis, narrative structure, and storytelling, to help you produce high-quality content.

Collaboration is a key part of this programme. You will work in production teams to create a variety of media projects, including radio productions, digital short films and digital designs. You will also develop skills in content creation and marketing, using industry-standard software such as the Adobe Creative Suite.

Key areas of study include:

Content Creation

- Film production and technology
- Digital Design and Marketing

#### How will I be assessed?

You will be assessed on your practical work and coursework. Your work is both internally and externally assessed. You will be graded with a Pass or Fail grade.

### What Equipment Will I Need?

You will need writing materials, notebook and a USB memory stick. Learners are encouraged to utilise laptops and tablets in an interactive learning environment.
