- You must be aged between 14-24 years old
- The College be able to meet your needs

In the School Transition Link Programme, you will grow both academically and personally. You will follow a personalised curriculum designed to meet your needs, focusing on skills such as reading, writing, participating in group discussions, working independently, and managing tasks. The programme aims to enhance your confidence and abilities, preparing you for a full-time vocational course at college. Success in the programme requires regular attendance and dedication to your best effort.

### Course Content

- Agree, set and achieve personal targets that prepare you for your future goals

- Develop your enterprise skills in workshop sessions
- Enjoy fun activities during 'enrichment' sessions
- Take part in volunteering activities
- Expand your IT skills using technology to learn
- Experience learning in a new environment with the support of staff to help you settle in and develop new skills you need for your next steps
